Jesus told him, not to murder, or steal, or lie. Jesus said to honor your father and mother, and love your neighbor as yourself.


The young man said he had kept all these commandments from his youth. He asked Jesus what he was still lacking.

Jesus said "Go and sell all you have and give to the poor. Then you will have treasure in heaven, and come and follow me."


When the young man heard those words, he went away very sad, because he had great riches.
