

Suitcase to Heaven Skit

One person has a suitcase packed and plans to take it to heaven. The second person goes through the packed items with him and tells him about heaven.

Requires:

2 people

You will need:

Small suitcase or duffle bag

Aspirin bottle

Life insurance policy (printable prop at the end of this lesson)

Night light

Piece of fruit (real or plastic)

Dress or dress shirt

Wallet or piggy bank

Box of tissues

Reservations (printable prop at the end of this lesson)

Person 1: Hi, I see you have a suitcase there. Are you going on vacation?

Person 2: Nope.

Person 1: Where are you going?

Person 2: Heaven.

Person 1: Heaven?

Person 2: Yep, I'm all packed and ready to go to heaven.

Person 1: You're packed to go to heaven?

Person 2: That's right I'm all set to go to heaven. Got everything I need.

Person 1: Hmmm. Let's see what you got there.

Person 2: (Removes aspirin bottle from suitcase.) I got me some aspirin. Sometimes when I travel, I get a headache. So, I'm bringing some aspirin, in case I get a headache.

Person 1: No, you won't get a headache in heaven. The bible teaches that there's no sickness or pain in heaven. You won't get a headache. You won't have any pain. You don't need aspirin in heaven. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: (Put aspirin bottle down outside of suitcase and take out life insurance policy.) I got my life insurance policy.

Person 1: Life Insurance policy?

Person 2: Yep, that's right. I always got me a life insurance policy. You just never know when you're going to need it.

Person 1: No, you don't need a life insurance policy in heaven. There won't be any death in heaven. We're going to live forever with Jesus. Nobody is going to die in heaven. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: (Put the life insurance policy down outside the suitcase and take out nightlight.) Anytime I go someplace new I always bring my nightlight. Sometimes I get a little scared of the dark.

Person 1: You won't need a nightlight in heaven. It's never dark in heaven. The lamb is the light, and it's light all the time. You won't need a nightlight in heaven. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: (Put the nightlight down outside the suitcase and take out banana.) I'm bringing a banana in case I get hungry and want a snack.

Person 1: You don't need to bring fruit to heaven. There will be fruit in heaven. Do you know that the bible teaches that there is a tree there that grows twelve kinds of fruit? No, you don't need to bring fruit to heaven. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: (Put the fruit down outside the suitcase and take out dress/shirt.) I got this nice dress/shirt. I want to look my very best when I'm in heaven.

Person 1: You don't need to bring dress clothes to heaven. In heaven we are going to have beautiful white robes. They will be more beautiful than any clothes we've ever seen. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: (Put the clothes down outside the suitcase and take out wallet/piggy bank.) Anytime I go anywhere I always take a little money with me. You never know what you are going to need.

Person 1: No, you're not going to need money there. God will supply everything we need. Why don't you know the street in heaven is gold? There are twelve gates, each made of a giant pearl. The walls are jasper. No, money's no good in heaven. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: (Put the money down outside the suitcase and take out tissues.) I always take a box of tissues when I go somewhere. Sometimes I get sad and cry.

Person 1: You won't need those tissues. There's no sadness in heaven. We won't cry because God will wipe away all tears. What else do you have in there?

Person 2: I only have one thing left. It's the most important thing of all. I know I will need this. This is the information for my travel agent so I can make reservations and go to heaven.

Person 1: No, you can't make arrangements with a travel agent to go to heaven. There's only one way to heaven. Jesus said He's the way.

Person 2: I don't understand.

Person 1: The bible teaches us that everyone has sinned, those are the bad things that we do. No sin can enter heaven. We deserve to be punished for our sin, but Jesus loves us so much, He took the punishment for us by dying on the cross. If we believe that in our heart, and ask Him to forgive us, and with His help turn from our sins, when this life is over, we can have a home in heaven.
